Role play, dramatic play, imaginative play – everyone agrees it's essential. It starts with a dress-up unit with lots of storage space. Click the arches into place, toss a Flowie over them, and you have an instant stage or cosy space. Made of transparent netting, the Flowie will give children a sense of being in their own world while you can still supervise.

The compact drama centre saves on space and serves younger children. Instead of trays for storage, we provided a dress-up box.


